Description

ringposstyle is specified inside options such as `ring()` and is typically used in conjunction with *clockposstyle* (see [\[G-4\] clockposstyle](#)) to specify a position for titles, subtitles, etc.

Syntax

ringposstyle is

$\# \qquad 0 \leq \# \leq 100, \# \text{ real}$
