

Description

textsizestyle specifies the size of the text.

textsizestyle is specified inside options such as the `size()` suboption of `title()` (see [\[G-3\]](#) *title_options*):

```
. graph ..., title("My title", size(textsizestyle)) ...
```

quarter	one-fourth the size of the graph
third	one-third the size of the graph
