Description

The `window` command lets you open, close, and manage the windows in Stata's interface. Using the subcommands of `window menu`, you can also add and delete menu items from the **User** menu from Stata's main menu bar. `window push` adds *command_line* to the Review window.

Syntax

<code>window fopen ...</code>	Display open dialog box
<code>window fsave ...</code>	Display save dialog box
<code>window manage subcmd ...</code>	Manage window characteristics
<code>window menu subcmd ...</code>	Create menus
<code>window push command_line</code>	Copy command into Review window
<code>window stopbox subcmd ...</code>	Display message box
