

**collect style tex** — Collection styles for L<sup>A</sup>T<sub>E</sub>X files

## Description

`collect style tex` specifies styles to be used when exporting a table from a collection to a L<sup>A</sup>T<sub>E</sub>X file.

`collect style tex`, typed without any options, will clear the existing L<sup>A</sup>T<sub>E</sub>X appearance styles for the current collection.

## Quick start

Specify that tables not be centered on the page when exported from the current collection to a L<sup>A</sup>T<sub>E</sub>X file

```
collect style tex, ncentering
```

Clear the current L<sup>A</sup>T<sub>E</sub>X appearance styles

```
collect style tex
```

## Syntax

Specify styles to be used when exporting a collection to a L<sup>A</sup>T<sub>E</sub>X file

```
collect style tex [ , options ]
```

Clear existing L<sup>A</sup>T<sub>E</sub>X appearance styles

```
collect style tex [ , name(cname) ]
```

*options*

Description

---

`name(cname)`

apply L<sup>A</sup>T<sub>E</sub>X styles to collection *cname*

`[no]begintable`

specify whether to use L<sup>A</sup>T<sub>E</sub>X table environment

`[no]centering`

specify whether to center table horizontally on the page

---

## Options

`name(cname)` specifies that the L<sup>A</sup>T<sub>E</sub>X styles be applied to collection *cname*.

When `name(cname)` is specified without any other options, L<sup>A</sup>T<sub>E</sub>X styles are cleared from collection *cname*.

The default in both cases is to apply the style changes to the current collection.

`begintable` and `nobegintable` control whether to use the L<sup>A</sup>T<sub>E</sub>X table environment.

`begintable` specifies that `collect export` use the L<sup>A</sup>T<sub>E</sub>X table environment. In addition, table titles are specified using `\caption`.

`nobegintable` specifies that `collect export` not use the L<sup>A</sup>T<sub>E</sub>X table environment.

`centering` and `nocentering` control whether to center the table horizontally on the page.

`centering` specifies that `collect export` center the table horizontally on the page.

`nocentering` specifies that `collect export` not center the table horizontally on the page.

`collect style tex` allows you to specify styles for the table that you will export to a L<sup>A</sup>T<sub>E</sub>X file with `collect export`. If you do not like the change you have made, you can clear the L<sup>A</sup>T<sub>E</sub>X appearance styles by typing the following:

```
. collect style tex
```

This change will be applied to the current collection. To make this change for another collection, specify the collection name with the `name()` option.

## Stored results

`collect style tex` stores the following in `s()`:

```
Macros  
  s(collection) name of collection
```
